### Activity: Verb tenses – past, present and future

#### Remember:

When we write about things that happened earlier, we write in the past tense.

We use the present tense to write about things that are happening now. When we write about things in the future, we write in the future tense.

Past tense: I wrote a story yesterday. Present tense: I am writing a story.

Future tense: Tomorrow I will write a story.

Sort the following sentences into either the past, present and future tense. You can see the first one has been circled in red as it is in the past tense. Choose three colours of your choice to sort them into the different tenses.

James jumped into the sea.

The dog chased the cat.

The bell will ring at 3 o'clock.

We are going out to play later.

The cat is chasing a mouse.

We ran to the park to play.

The match is in full swing.

Mr Jones is driving the bus.

I am reading about Auggie.

Are you watching television?

I will be ten next month.

I will play with you after tea.

We went to France last year.

I got all my Maths right.
