A line is left clear after the address, before writing the date, which should start in line with the rest of the address. Postcodes use capital letters, but no other punctuation.

A line is left clear before putting the name of the letter's receiver. The first sentence of the letter starts below the comma following the name of the person you are writing to. The rest is paragraphed, with the final signing off arranged in the centre of the paper.
